#### **ECC Team Notes**



**Bridgeport:** The UB men's soccer team heads into this week's action with a 3-4-0 overall record and a 1-1-0 ECC mark. Senior Leandro Avila leads Bridgeport in scoring with five points on two goals and on assist so far in 2019. Goncalo Mendes and Oscar Facey are second in scoring, each with four points. This week, the Purple Knights play road matches at Dominican (NY) on Monday and Daemen on Saturday.



**Daemen:** Daemen dropped to 0-7 overall and 0-2 in ECC play following losses to California (Pa.) and nationally-ranked Mercy last week. Freshmen Alex Christidis and Chris Cox netted their first career goals in the losses. Eithan Hahn made a career-high 10 saves against Mercy. The Wildcats host Salem and Bridgeport this week.



**District of Columbia:** The Firebirds moved to 2-6 (1-0 ECC) on the year after splitting a pair of games last week. They fell 2-1 to Seton Hill before topping Bridgeport, 1-0, in their first ECC game of the year. Danillo Muniz Beserra scored both goals on the week, while Javier Abadia posted a shutout with five saves against UB. Up next for the Firebirds is a non-conference tilt with Bloomsburg on October 5.



**Mercy:** The No. 9 Mercy College men's soccer team went 2-0 on the week with wins over Jefferson and Daemen. The Mavericks were led by senior Ignacio Mangada who had a goal and two assists. Mercy resumes action on Wednesday when they play at Georgian Court at 3:30 pm.



**Molloy:** The Lions fell to the New York Tech Bears, 3-2, in overtime Saturday, September 28, to move to 3-2-1 overall and 0-1 in ECC play. Senior Anthony Cestaro and junior Luis Mata netted goals, and senior Carlos Bonilla tallied two assists.



**New York Tech:** Redshirt freshman Che Richards scored the overtime winner and the Bears improved to 2-0 in the ECC with a 3-2 victory at Molloy on Saturday. Tech had dropped a nonconference game to Bentley on Tuesday on a penalty kick awarded in overtime.



**Queens:** The Queens College men's soccer team claimed a 2-0 victory over Seton Hill (PA) in the Knights' lone match-up of the week on Saturday in the suburbs of Pittsburgh. Leo Pinto and Emgi Gousse scored the goals for QC in the non-conference tilt. Queens will square off with Roberts Wesleyan on Saturday in an ECC match-up in Rochester.



**Roberts Wesleyan:** The Roberts Wesleyan men's soccer team suffered a 5-1 loss on the road to Saint Michael's on Wednesday but responded with a 3-0 win over St. Thomas Aquinas at home in the first ECC match of the season. The Redhawks will face Stonehill and Queens this week.
